Statement of Purpose


The purpose of this document, pursuant to the existing articulation agreement, is to serve as written notice and approval of corequisite changes to Fitchburg State University's Introduction to Education 5-12 and Introduction to Teaching English.

Amended Item

Those enrolled in Introduction to Education are required to register for MTEL 0001 unless the student already passed the Communication and Literacy MTEL. Mount Wachusett students who register for Fitchburg State's Introduction to Education are strongly encouraged to also register for MTEL 0001 at the same time. MWCC students who have passed the Communication and Literacy MTEL will have a smoother transition to Fitchburg State's Secondary Education and Middle School programs.

This course revision does not affect pre-established terms and conditions of the existing articulation agreement. All provisions, previously agreed to by the two institutions, remain in force. Refer to the 2024 articulation agreement document for details and conditions.

Fitchburg State University and Mount Wachusett Community College agree that this Amendment becomes effective on January 22, 2025 and is applicable to eligible students in the next semester of enrollment.
