  - 3) Clarifies that minor courses can be double-dipped with other General Education courses in the remaining Foundation and Exploration sections
  - 4) Specifies that General Education courses required by majors outside of the major requirements/major GPA calculation must be approved by the AUC, be included in the four-year plans, and be included with major requirements in the catalog
