2. Proposals to Recommend for Approval

AUC #123: Minor Changes to the Fall 2025 Academic Calendar

Franca Barricelli reviewed the history of the Fall 2025 Academic Calendar, after the passage of AUC #1 in Fall 2024 and changes made to AUC #1 by AUC #120 in May 2025. She discussed the new challenges that have arisen since the new proposal under discussion today (AUC #123) was posted, including a conflict with the coded semester start and end dates for Financial Aid. After a group discussion of the various considerations for the fall 2025 calendar (add/drop dates, the opening and closing of the residence halls, Development Day and student advising), Josh Cronin moved, with a second by Michael Burns, to return to the dates of AUC #1 as approved on 12/19/24, with the following changes:

- A. Move the opening of the residence halls for first-year students to Sunday, August 31 (from Monday, September 1, Labor Day);
- B. Change the language of the all-campus event on Wednesday, September 3 to Opening Convocation (from President's Address);
- C. Shift the date of the Last day to add a course in College Scheduler to Wednesday, September 10 (from Thursday, September 11);
- Shift the date of the last day to drop a course in College Scheduler/last day to add a course with permission of instructor to Wednesday, September 17 (from Thursday, September 18);
- E. Shift new student advising to Tuesday, September 2 (from Thursday, September 4) to align it with fall Development Day for Faculty;
- F. On Thursday, December 18, add "Residence Halls close, 7:00 p.m."
