



I do not think my personal social network gained at Fitchburg has helped me, but the relationships I


 developed with faculty has proved immensely beneficial to my future. I also think the socioeconomic diversity of FSU helped me appreciate perspectives better than had I attended a private school.


17. Please select the Degree you completed at Fitchburg State University from the list below.




18. Please select the major field your studied for your degree:
