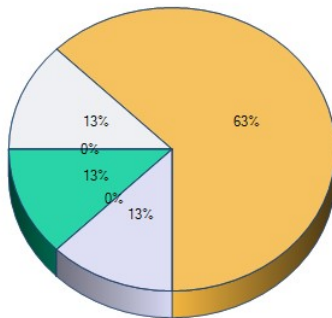

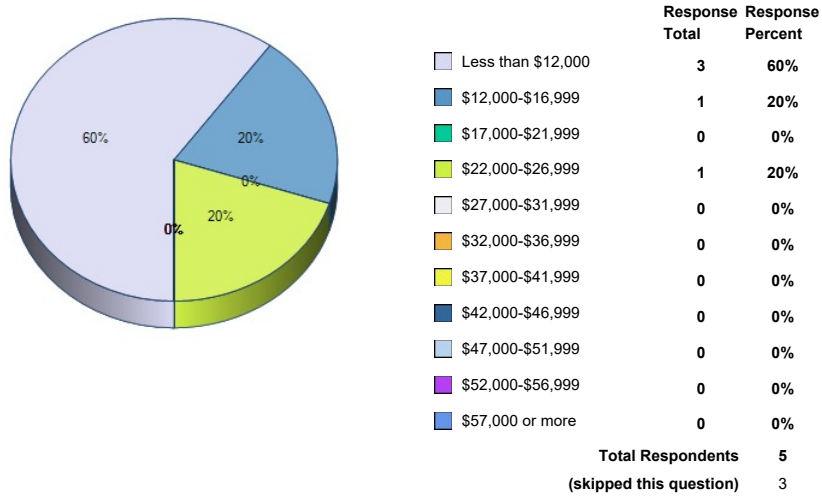

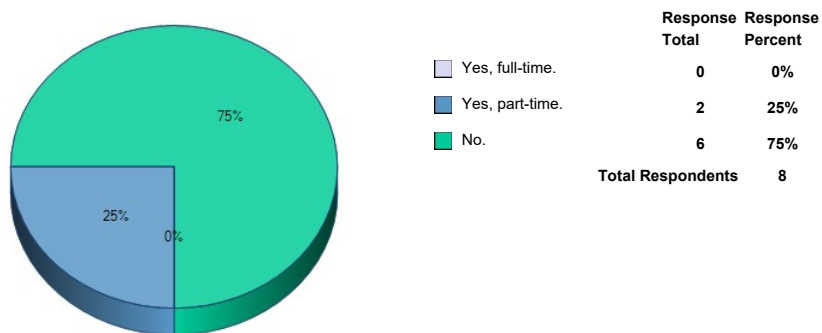

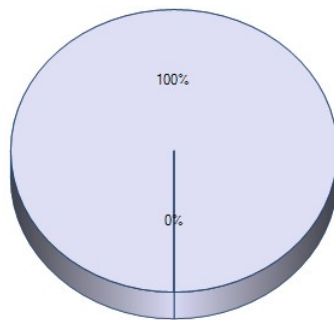

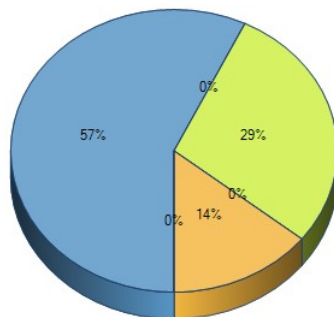
130. During all or most of your semesters at the University, did you attend full-time or part-time?

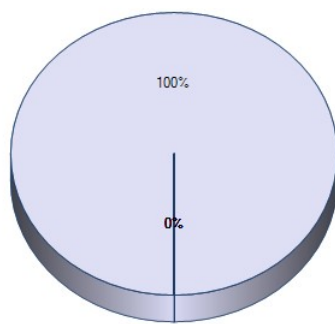
131. Average hours per week worked while attending the University.
