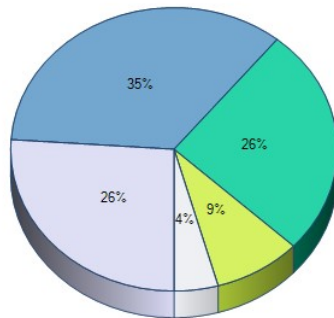

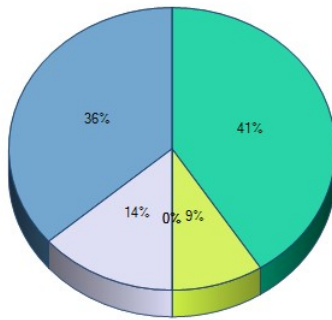

- Training into your staff needs to be done. There was terrible communication throughout different departments. Paperwork that needed to be filed between multiple people always seemed to get lost and had to be redone. Advisors are close to useless. My advisor was not very versed on what I needed done to complete my degree and could not point me in good directions. I ended up doing it myself after a single visit. Also, I have never seen such a waste of my education time and money as a class with professor Noonan. Every class taken with him was a guaranteed 4.0 or 3.0 but there was no learning. He spent more time talking about his personal political beliefs then material. I would never return to this school. You were the cheapest option but I guess you get what you pay for. But, while I give you this negative, Professor Scapperone and Greenwood were some of the best teachers I have ever experienced. I left their classes truly learning something and they care about their jobs. You need more teachers like them.
