

Many of the current industry standards are not present in the coursework and it's very obvious when you reach your second year that it is lacking this.

I feel that my major is underfunded and that there isn't enough faculty to cover all different the aspects that are needed in the field, especially when certain faculty that teach key aspects are on sabbatical. I also feel that it should be stressed to obtain real field experience.

Lastly, this survey question in particular says "experiences at FSC" instead of FSU. I was amused by this.




### 128. Cumulative GPA.




