




1. Please select the semester will you complete your program requirements from the list below:




2. Please select the Degree you are currently completing at Fitchburg State University from the list below:



3. Please select the major field your studied for your degree:





This is the first program that I had to provide/figure out my own internship. I don't feel this was too difficult since I have many years of experience already as a nurse. However, I am not sure that the follow up from program, to internship, to student would be as effective for students entering the nursing program with little

- 7. or no experience. My last internship, during the semester there was no contact at all between the woman I was shadowing, and my professor. I have completed both a paramedic program and another nursing program where the instructors were onsite with students, or checked in while on site with students, or requested some type of feedback this was not the case.

I have had a wonderful experience over the last few years in the MSN graduate program. Finding clinical experiences to complete the required hours would have been much easier if we had more information and support from the nursing faculty. I practically had to beg for a list of previous placements when I began my clinical. By narrowing down a list of willing clinical sites, students will have a better clinical experience. I understand that this is a unique major, but if it has been part of the Fitchburg State University academic program, the college of nursing must provide more support in finding appropriate placements in Massachusetts.

12. For the final course, nursing research, I consistently reached out by phone and email to the professor/advisor for feedback on my paper. Most of the time I did not receive a reply, and had to make multiple attempts to reach her before she would give feedback on the progress of the paper. I felt that her feedback was snarky at times, and points were taken off of grading for things that she made corrections on, as I made the changes she requested. Reaching out for help seemed futile at times. I believe that although I have finished my research paper and am graduating, I would have benefitted from having an advisor who was not the professor for the course. It seems that her mind is focused elsewhere and not on advising students in their last semester, which should be a major focus. I have heard similar comments and concerns from other graduate students. I trust that this feedback is anonymous and that I will not be penalized for my comments. I look forward to graduation on December 21, 2018.

The science department is full of some of the most excellent instructors I've ever had the privelege of being educated by. I think for a smaller-scale institution the academic and administrative departments are






20. How many times did you change your major at Fitchburg State University?






22. To which gender identity do you most identify?




23. To which racial heritage do you predominantly identify?
