


3. Are you satisfied with the course of your career thus far?





I have the financial consequence of a fifth year of school. The final advisor I had made up for it, I am still happy with the education program. Just my feedback.



I love the campus, small and intimate classroom sizes, and the hardworking and knowledgeable faculty that taught students pursuing a degree in education and the life sciences. I learned a lot from the experienced professors and really love how the McKay school is connected to the campus, which allowed me to get direct experience working with students and teachers in the field. Though all these attribute make FSU a fantastic school, I personally feel that I was cheated due to the requirements the school holds for students seeking to go into teaching.

2. I'm not sure if things have changes since 2015, but in order to graduate with a B.S. in Education, students are required to pass all of their MTELs before the last semester of their senior year so they can complete their practicum and later teach. This requirement was not fully made known to me until I reached my Junior year. I think it is unfair to make that a requirement, especially since I worked hard to ensure that I would graduate with a B.S. in Education, only to be forced to graduate with an Interdisciplinary degree. I later found out that other academic institutions did not make that a requirement. I felt like I wasted 4 years.

Though things worked out for me with respects to my career/profession, I do feel bad for the many others that are not in the field they desired to be in due to this requirement.




**17.** Please select the major field studied for your degree:



 $18. \ \ \text{To which gender identity do you most identify}?$ 




