






1. Please select the semester will you complete your program requirements from the list below:



2. Please select the Degree you are currently completing at Fitchburg State University from the list below:





- 4. More exposure to different career paths within or using your major would have been helpful. There are many different avenues to use an education degree that were never explored or offered that taking different classes to cover general requirements could have been better utilized.
- 5. I love it here. But in my field, I can talk to every single professor and ask them all the same question and I would get a different answer from each one. Typically advising questions.
 - While I feel I have gotten a decent education, I was frequently frustrated by the lack of continuity between syllabi, Blackboard, and emailed instructions. At least three of my professors had different due dates for assignments written in all three places, and would be unhelpful when asked.
- Additionally, the courses within the Special Education major were mismatched in terms of workload. Some courses required hours of work each night, some required a few hours per week, and some required minutes each week. There needs to be a balance when the intent of an online graduate program is to be convenient for working professionals.










22. To which gender identity do you most identify?




23. To which racial heritage do you predominantly identify?
