Meanwhile, what are the biggest careers now? All industries need workers versed in User Experience Design. I feel like the program could have easily pivoted to this much more relevant field as opposed to game design which is so limited in its application. I just wish my program was taken as seriously as I took it.









23. To which racial heritage do you predominantly identify?


