
All the participants were known to the researcher from her teaching at various local universities, but were not currently her students.




The central part of the chapter will closely examine these areas of tension, reconceptualizing them as barriers to praxis and agentic identity formation.

FINDINGS AND IMPLICATIONS

Guided by a deeper understanding, they possessed a more sophisticated view of themselves as teachers, and, building on this sense of self, could offer their nearpeers a more dynamic and empowered means of constructing a teaching identity in which their divergent personas in the two worlds could align and entwine, rather than divergence and conflict. In short, they found a way to learn from tensions and to practice (and model) a different identity paradigm.

FINDINGS AND IMPLICATIONS TENSIONS AS TOOLS



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"In terms of my identity with the person I was paired with, I think that we had very different teaching philosophies. In the beginning, I was like, 'Oh, this is going to be a long experience.' But, then it ended up being a wonderful experience because we were so different. [I] don't think you necessarily have to be paired with someone who has the same teaching philosophy, but just with someone who respects that you are different." (Abigail)

FINDINGS AND IMPLICATIONS TENSIONS AS TOOLS

In sharing her experience, Abigail modeled her ability to use tensions as a productive tool for agentic identity formation; a lesson she offered both to her nearpeers in this study and to all novice teachers.










A couple of teachers in the study, however, found ways of successfully inhabiting a more synergistic identity. These teachers embraced a constructivist philosophy that conjoined the roles of teacher and learner.

"You know, I think the comment that you're always a student, in a sense, rings completely true especially when you're a teacher because you're always learning. And no matter how young you are or how old you are in the profession, how many years, I think you can always learn." (Abigail)
