Both times, I received poor responses that almost seemed like they were given with attitude. Unluckily, I had her in one of my classes as well. To start, her syllabus was a mess, and she was completely unorganized. Due dates, page numbers, etc made little sense. There

- 2. was a group project that was done throughout the course, yet the prompt did not explain what was expected. I had someone who would repeatedly plagiarize on discussion questions, and they never got called out despite my acknowledgement of it. I had the same person in my very next class and the new professor called out the individual on their first post saying that his efforts were malicious and not allowed. I know that I am not the only one who feels this way about her. (To provide some support to my opinion I believe I got an A- in the class, so I'm not bitter or out for revenge)
- 3. Might want to change this question it has FSC not FSU. Mike Leamy is awesome.



to take points off an assignment, then tell me why so I can improve. Most just left me in the dark.




126. Class standing when you enrolled at Fitchburg State University to earn your current degree.




127. Total SEMESTERS it took you to earn your degree.



128. Cumulative GPA.




