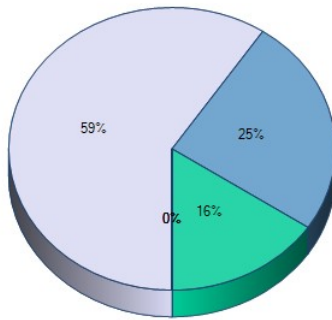

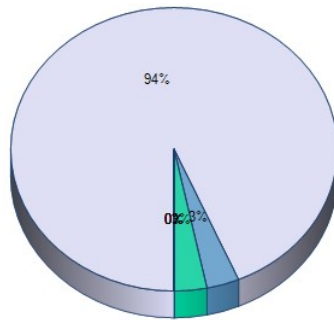

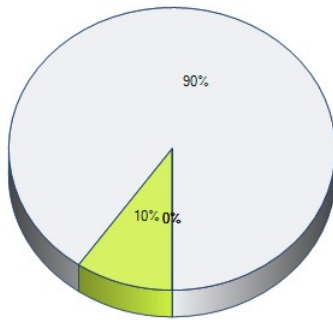

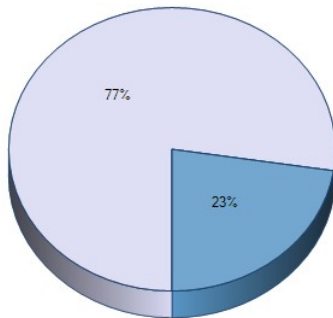
128. Cumulative GPA.

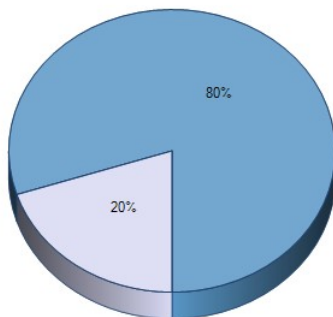
129. Did you attend the University continuously while working on your degree?

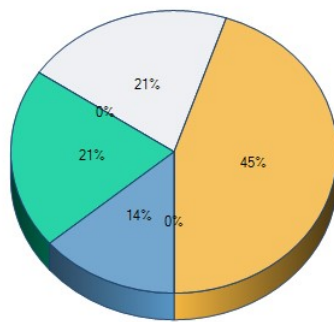
130. During all or most of your semesters at the University, did you attend full-time or part-time?

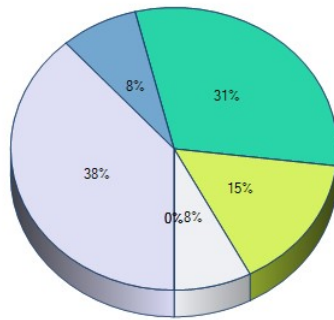
