It is my privilege to inform you that the Human Services baccalaureate program at Fitchburg State University has been reaccredited by the Council for Standards in Human Service Education (CSHSE) for the period June 2021 through June 2026.

The program is in compliance with all standards and is accredited with no conditions.

PROGRAM STRENGTHS

- Faculty members have longevity and only 15% of offered program courses are taught by adjuncts.
- The program successfully transitioned to virtual instruction during the pandemic.
- Program is increasing enrollment by marketing with two-year programs

The next accreditation cycle will be an Interim Report and Review and must be completed by June 2026. There will be no site visit. **A copy of this letter must be included in your next self-study.**
