


Fitchburg State University Today

Nursing students receive white coats at new ceremony


The Nursing Department launched a new tradition last week with the inaugural White Coat Ceremony, wherein students about to begin their clinical rotations were presented with the symbolic garments.


Check out our winter instrumental and choral concerts
