Briefly describe new program/concentration as it will appear in university catalog:

The TESL concentration in the M.Ed. in Curriculum and Teaching (non-licensure) is designed to provide current and future educators an opportunity to be equipped with the knowledge of Teaching English Learners. With this knowledge, teachers can be better prepared for the increasing diversity in our schools.

This program consists of coursework in order to meet the subject matter knowledge requirements for the ESL teacher license put forth by the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education.

Anticipated enrollment is 5-10 students in the first year, with enrollment increasing as the program becomes better known. There are already adjuncts teaching the TESL courses, and I do not anticipate needing more than one section per semester. Rationale Rationale and expected outcomes for new program: The TESL certificate program has been running for a year now with increased interest. From the start, students have wanted to be able to combine the certificate courses with the Master's degree. This allows the concentration of TESL to be added to the Curriculum and Teaching (C&T) Master's of Education non-licensure program. Students have shown interest in wanting a degree that says TESL.
