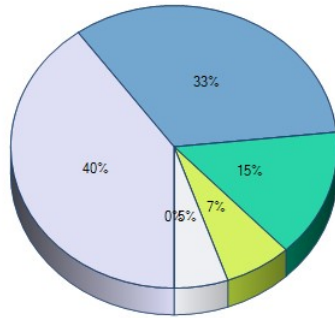

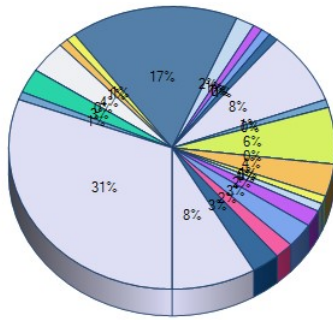

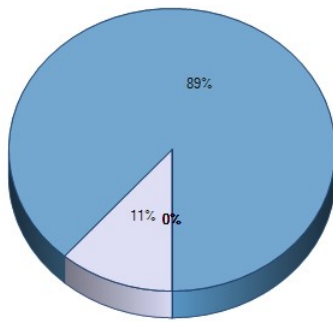
14. What did we not ask you about but you feel we should know?

I feel as this may be a difficult task and not one I am educated on, but how can FSU create an environment where individuals are able to grow more rapidly or slowly, based on their understanding, capabilities, etc. One of the best experiences I had was an education program outside Fitchburg State, which was at Marlboro College. We created a feature film by the end of the semester, whilst having numerous hands on classes where the learning was incredibly taught by teachers currently working in the field. This program was expensive undoubtedly, but how can Fitchburg State partner more with actual film organizations or get more real with how they approach the learning could be helpful. I found at Fitchburg State I was stunted by the slow rate learning, the reteaching of old content, and general lack of advanced learning. In one semester at Marlboro College I felt ready to enter the field, learned much more than I ever did at Fitchburg State, and gained an understanding of film, as well as the world that was far beyond anything that came before. I would recommend giving them a go and see.

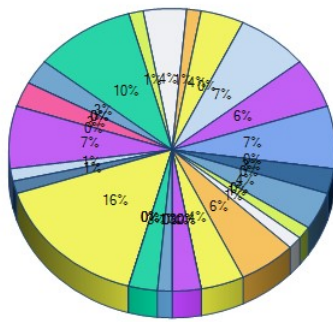

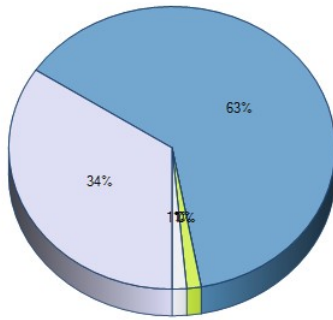

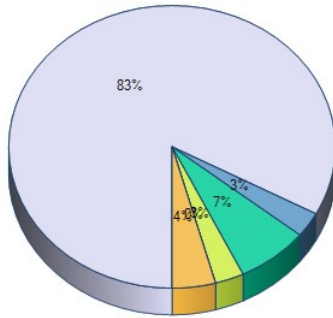

17. To which gender identity do you most identify?



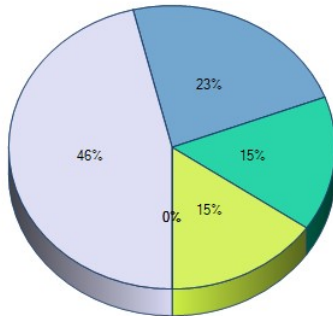
